ORDER OF VIGIL

FRIDAY APRIL 5TH

7:00pm	Mass
8:00pm	Begin Station by leaving the Cathedral and proceeding to the Gillooly Hall. Please cross the road with care at the pedestrian crossing situated at the junction with Adelaide Street.
By 12am Midnight	Make your way safely back to the Cathedral once again using the pedestrian crossing.

SATURDAY APRIL 6TH

2:00am	Third Station
3:30am	Fourth Station
5:am	Fifth Station
7:00am	Sacrament of Reconciliation available in the Cathedral
8:00am	Mass
8:30am	Upstairs in Sacristy Pilgrims Breakfast (dry toast and black tea)

FACILITIES

- The Cathedral - Public Worship, Stations, Vigil, St Patrick's Cross, St Brigid's Cross
- Gillooly Hall - Penitential Beds, St Patrick's Cross, St Brigid's Cross, Quiet space/ Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.

We invite you to return to the Cathedral before Easter to complete Stations number Six, Seven, Eight and Nine in your own time.


These can be completed over the course of a number of occasions.

ORDER OF STATION

- ✦ Begin the Station with a visit to the Blessed Sacrament
- ✦ Go to St Patrick's Cross .
Kneel and say one Our Father, one Hail Mary and one Creed.
Kiss the Cross
- ✦ Go to St Brigid's Cross.
Kneel and say three Our Fathers, three Hail Marys and one Creed.
With your back to the Cross stand with arms fully outstretched and say three times "I renounce the World, the Flesh and the Devil."
- ✦ Walk slowly by your right hand four times around the Parish Hall while praying silently seven decades of the Rosary and one Creed at the end.
- ✦ Go to St Brigid's Bed (1). If there is a queue please join it.
- ✦ At the Bed:
1) Walk three times around the outside, by your right hand, while saying three Our Fathers, three Hail Marys and one Creed.
2) Kneel at the entrance to the Bed and say three Our Fathers, three Hail Marys and one Creed.
3) Walk three times around the inside and say three Our Fathers, three Hail Marys and one Creed.
4) Kneel at the Cross in the centre of the Bed and say three Our Fathers, three Hail Marys and one Creed for a fourth time.
Repeat these four exercises at the following two Beds:
- ✦ Saints Eithne & Fidelma's Bed (2)
- ✦ St Columba's Bed (3)
- ✦ Walk six times around the large Penitential Bed which comprises St Patrick's Bed (4) and that of St Ciarán of Clonmacnoise (5) and St Asicus (6) while saying six Our Fathers six Hail Marys and one Creed .
- ✦ Kneel at the entrance to St Patrick's Bed and say three Our Fathers, three Hail Marys and one

- ✦ Creed. Walk three times around the inside while repeating these prayers. Kneel at the Cross in the centre of the Bed and say them again.
- ✦ Kneel at the entrance to the Beds of St Ciarán of Clonmacnoise (5) and St Asicus (6) and say three Our Fathers, three Hail Marys and one Creed.
Walk three times around the inside of these Beds while repeating these prayers. Kneel at the Cross in the centre of these Beds and say them again.
- ✦ Go to the Waters Edge (7) and stand and say five Our Fathers, five Hail Mary's and one Creed.
Kneel and repeat these prayers. Make the sign of the Cross with the water as a reminder of your Baptism.
- ✦ Return to St Patrick's Cross kneel and say one Our Father, one Hail Mary and one Creed.
Return to the Cathedral and conclude the Station by reciting Psalm 16 (or by saying five Our Fathers, five Hail Marys and one Creed), for the Pope's intentions.
