## FROM THE DIOCESE

**Forming Disciples:** "The ministry of Jesus was not about establishing structures. During the three or four years of his earthly ministry, much of his time was spent inviting people into relationship with God and forming disciples. At the end of St. Matthew's Gospel, we read that he told those who were gathered with him to "go make disciples" (Mt. 28:19). That is the mission of the Church. If we have buildings, or management structures, these are not an end in themselves. All these things are of value if they serve the mission of the Church, which is to live as Jesus lived and to form new disciples." **Bishop Kevin Doran – Discipleship and Mission In Changing Times (Pastoral Letter 2020)** Commissioning of Catechists: Fifteen volunteer catechists will be commissioned for service in the Diocese of Elphin, by Bishop Kevin Doran, at Mass in Sligo Cathedral this Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> September at 4.00pm. There will be two teams of catechists, corresponding to the two regions of the Diocese. Due to Covid-19 restrictions, only the catechists and a limited number of invited guests will be in the Cathedral for Mass.
