## FROM THE DIOCESE

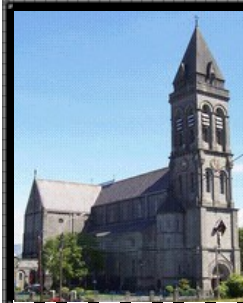
