FROM THE DIOCESE

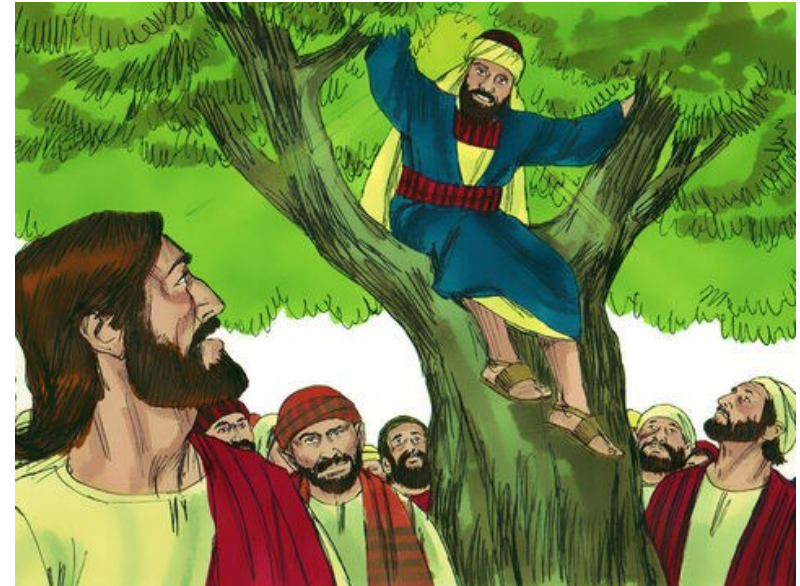
