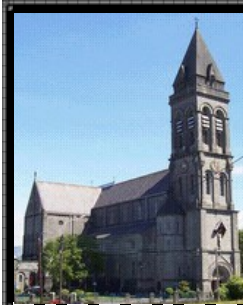

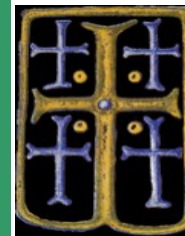
## FROM THE DIOCESE
