Dear Parishioners of the St. Mary's Cathedral Parish,

I am writing to let you know that I have appointed Fr. Victor Samugana as Parish Priest of the two parishes of Oran and Kilbride, in County Roscommon. Fr. Victor has served in the Cathedral Parish for seven years and has made an enormous contribution to the mission of the parish. I think particularly of his care of the sick and the bereaved, his faithful celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation and his support for various apostolic groups in the Parish. 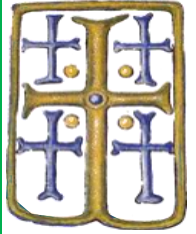
