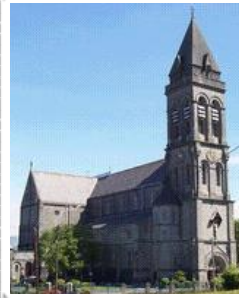

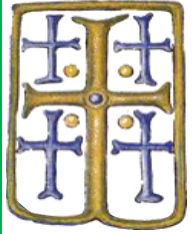
Pastoral Message of Bishop Kevin and Summary of Feedback from Recent Gatherings: This weekend, Bishop Kevin has issued a Pastoral Message to the faithful of the Diocese of Achonry and the Diocese of Elphin. This pastoral message follows on from a series of gatherings held in September and October regarding the proposed merger of the two dioceses which was announced by Pope Francis earlier this year. A summary of feedback from those six gatherings also forms part of Bishop Kevin's pastoral message.
