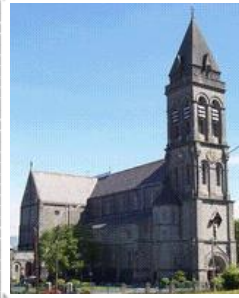
FROM THE DIOCESE

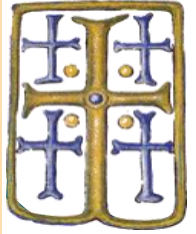
