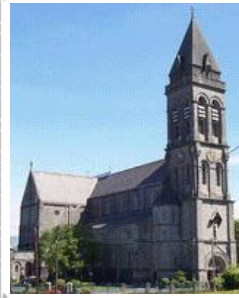

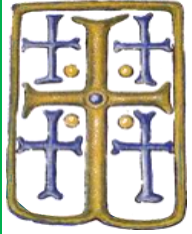
12.00 noon Mass – Healing through Prayer

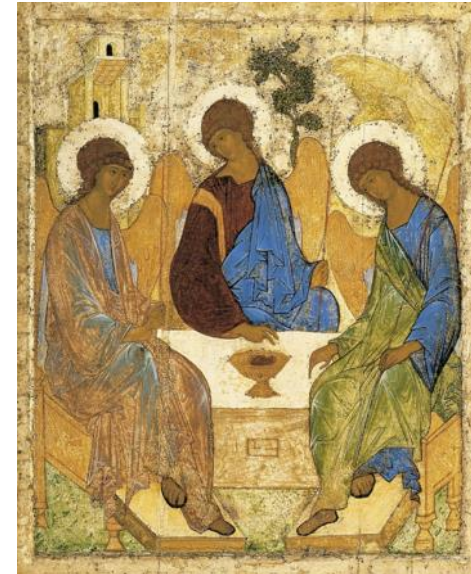

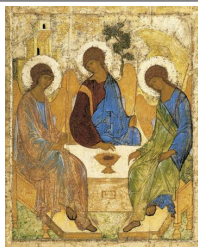

TODAY - Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time



Trinity by Andrei Rublev

The famous icon, executed by Rublev in the early fourteenth century, is one of only two extant icons that were definitively painted by him. Also titled "The Hospitality of Abraham" it demonstrates the three angels who visited Abraham at the Oak of Mamre. They are felt to represent the Holy Trinity, with the angel on the left representing God, (with all the colours in his cloak), Jesus in the middle (with his cloak of brown, the colour of the earth, revealing his humanity, and blue, the colour of the sky, revealing his divinity) and the Holy Spirit on the right (in blue indicating divinity and green indicating the life-giving force of the Spirit). The shape of the two angels on the outside form the outline of a chalice with Jesus in the middle. The gentle and peaceful interaction of the three angels reveals the perfect harmony of the persons of the Trinity.
